Assembly Instructions:

There are several ways to assemble this activity.

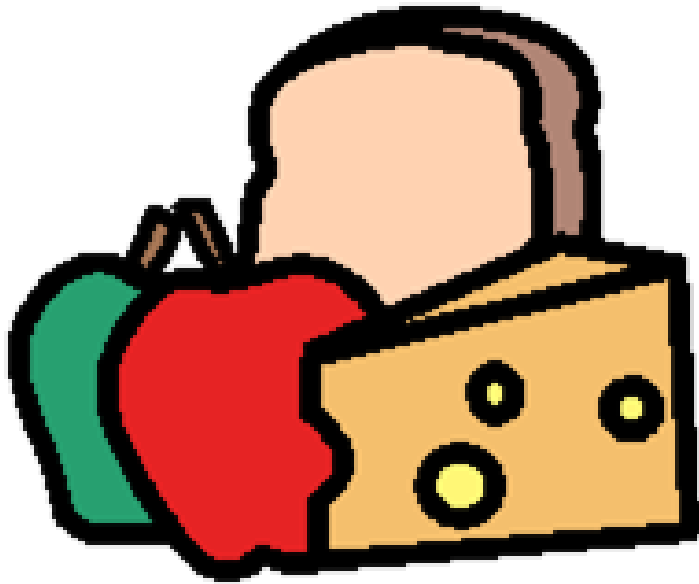
Example 1: print pages 2-6 glue the cover on the front of a file folder and then glue one page with the pictures on each side of the folder and laminate the folder and the other two pages with the words, (these will be used to 'match' to the picture or you could also print 2 copies of just the picture pages and use them to match picture to picture, or the words to match word to word, or match picture to word) How ever you decide is up to you this is just an idea example.

Example 2: Print all pages on card stock paper and laminate .Add **HARD Velcro** to the individual pieces these will be used to interact with the book. Laminate an additional blank piece of card stock to add a fold out page to be attached to the last page of the book. Add **SOFT Velcro** to make at least 3 columns on the page to 'house' the removable pieces.

** note: when adding fold out flaps to individual pages it is better to do this step before binding the whole book.*

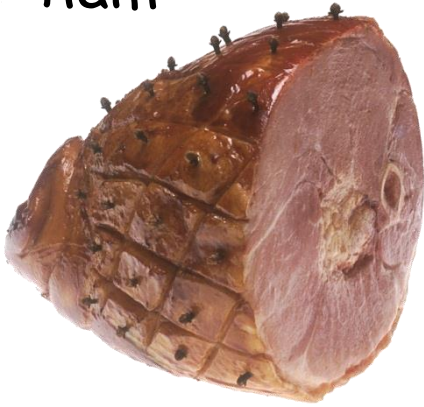
Once all the pages are assembled then bind the book. Use a binding machine and comb if available or use a 3 hole punch and add to a 3 ring binder.
