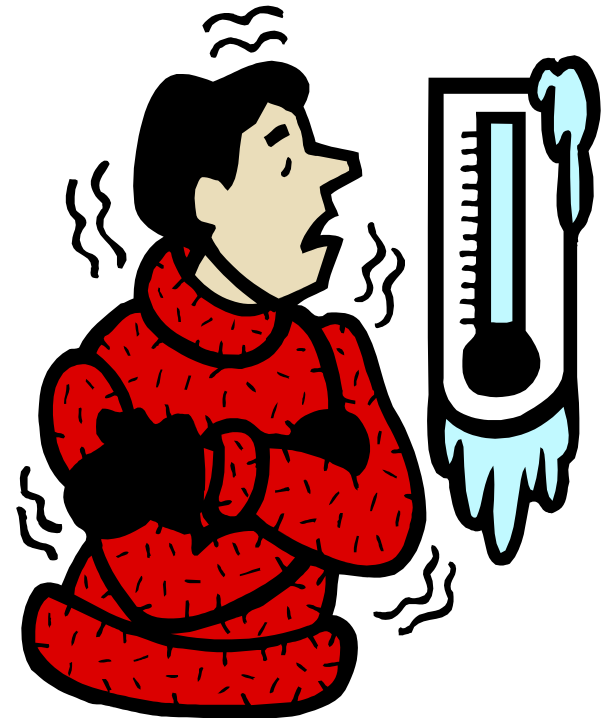
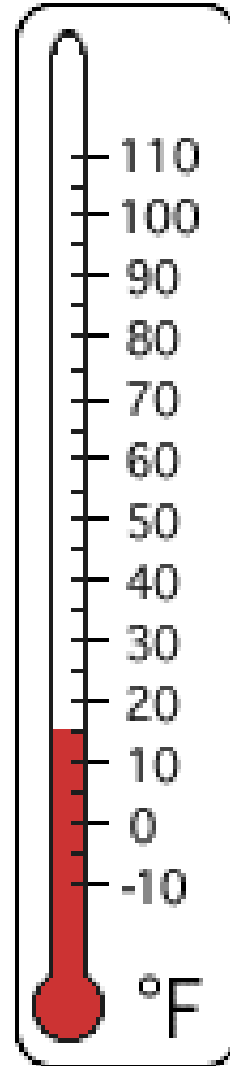
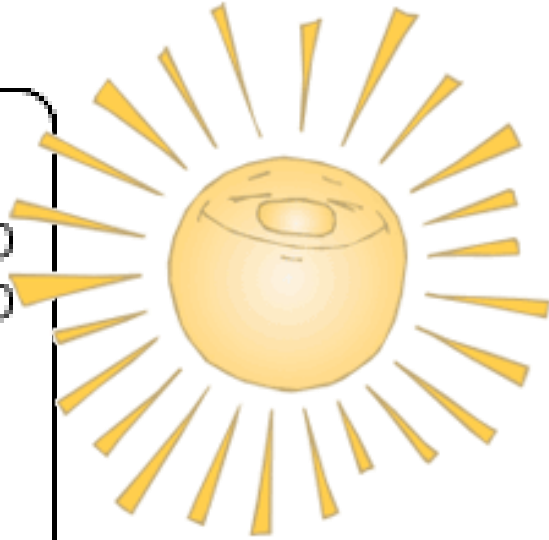
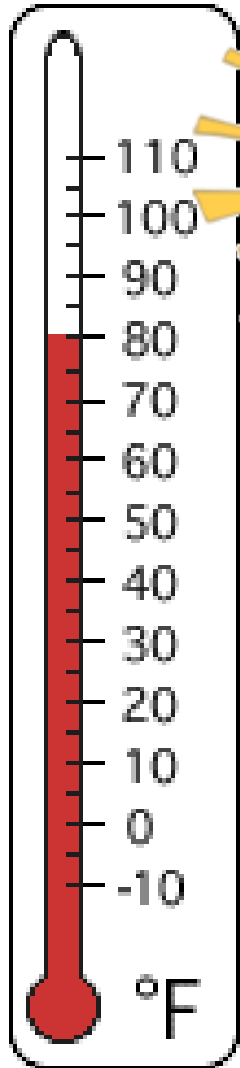
- Print all pages on card stock paper and laminate.
- Bind the book by using a binding machine and comb if available or use a 3 hole punch and add to a 3 ring binder.



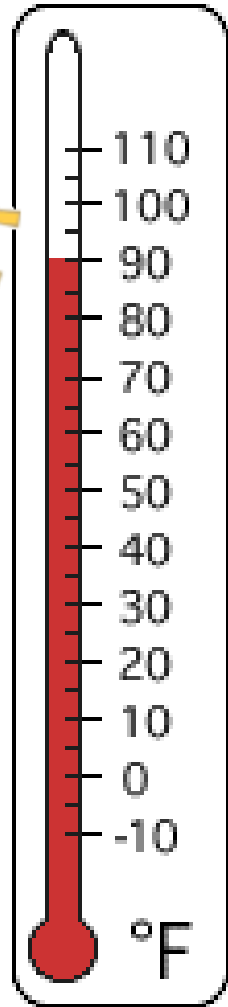
Weather



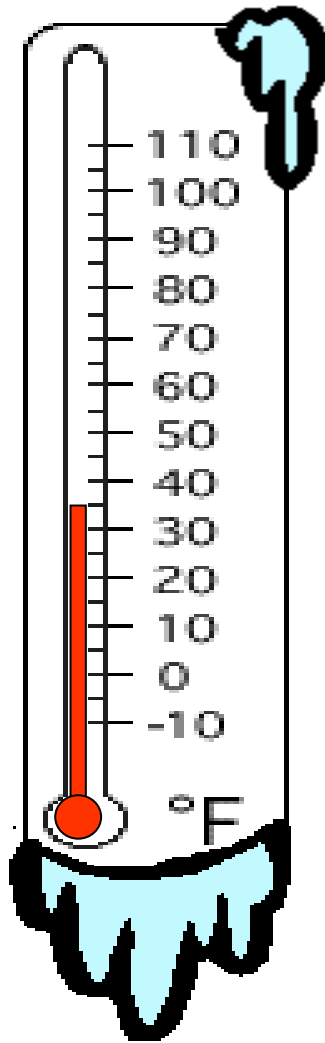
A thermometer measures temperature.



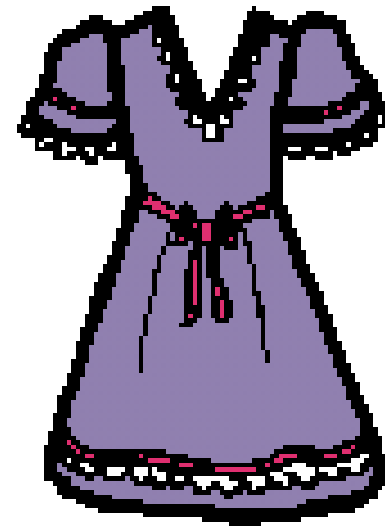
When the thermometer goes up
the weather gets warmer.



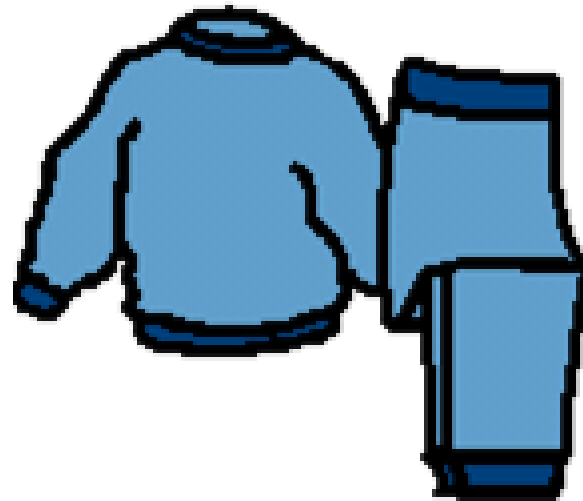
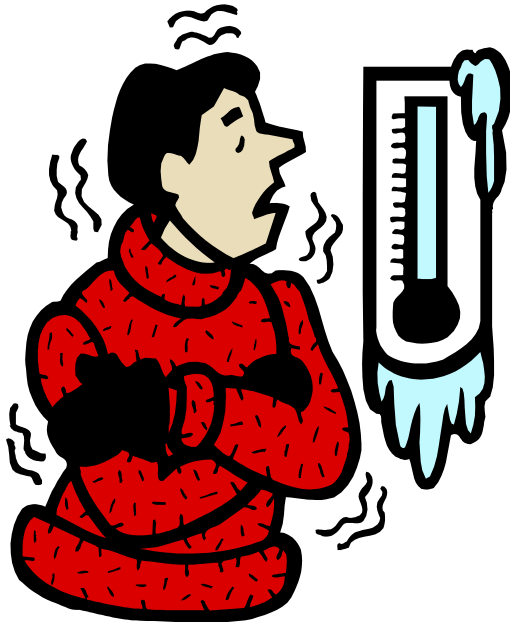
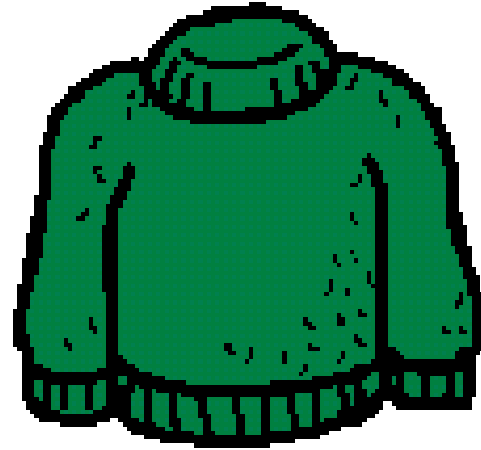
When the thermometer goes down
the weather gets cooler.



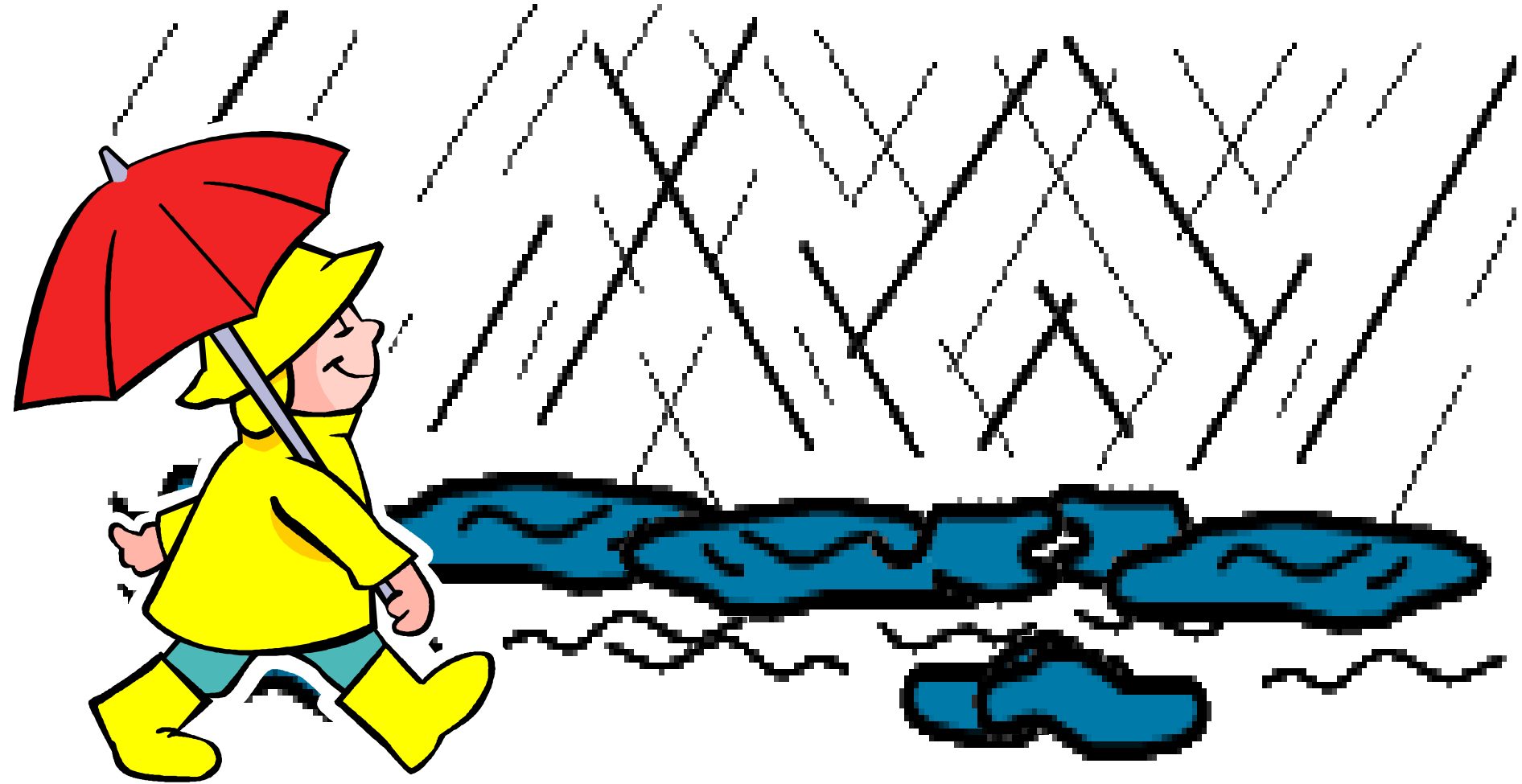
When the weather is hot we wear cool clothes.

an umbrella.



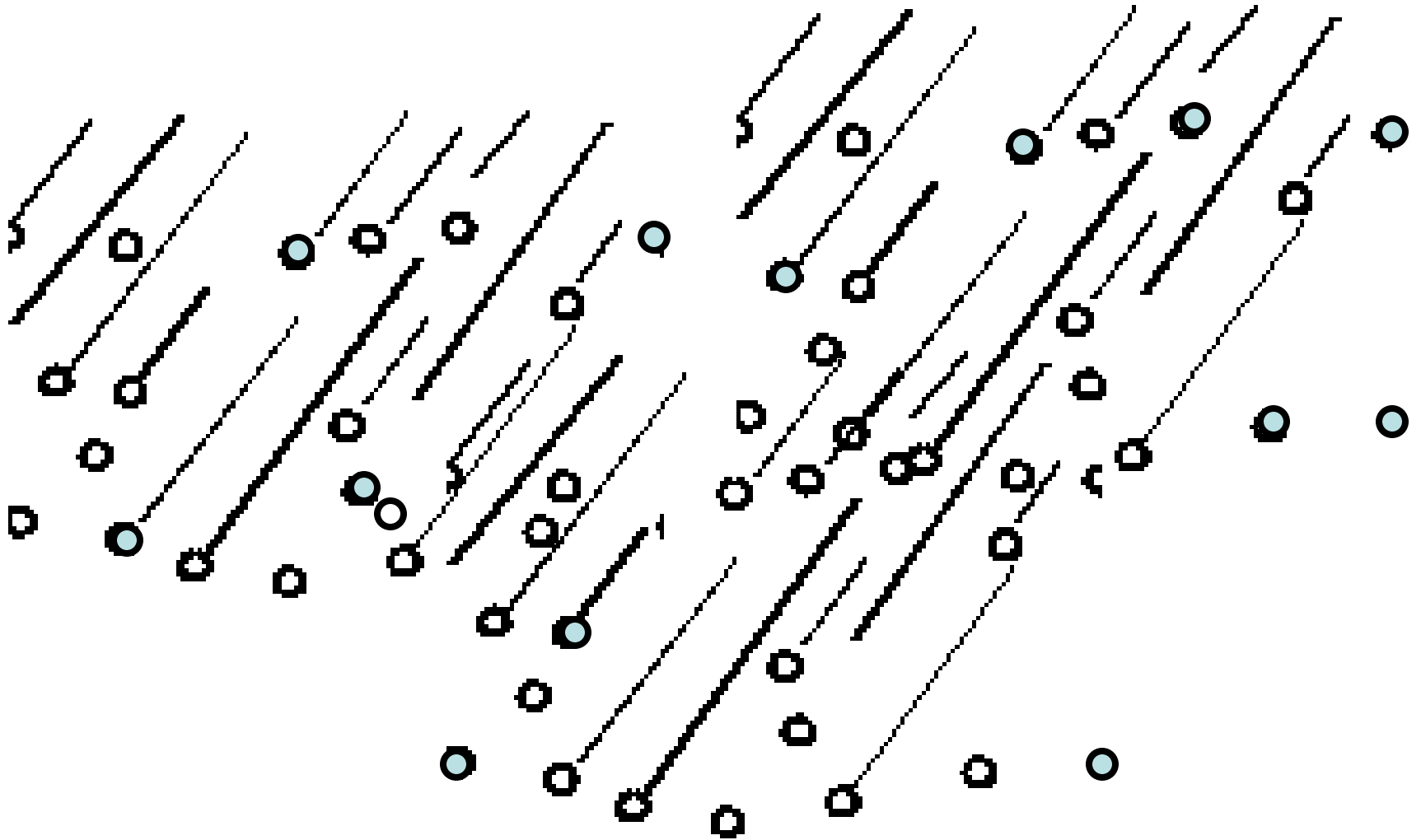
Tiny ice crystals are called snow.
