

Learning About The Quarter



Assembly Instructions:

- Print all pages on card stock paper and laminate
 - The gray ● indicates the spot to add **SOFT Velcro**
 - Add **HARD Velcro** to the individual pieces from pages 9-10 these will be used to interact with the book.
 - Laminate 2 additional blank pieces of card stock. Once laminated cut them in half lengthwise to add a fold out flap to be attached to pages 4-7 of the book. Add **SOFT Velcro** to make at least 1 column on the flap to 'house' the removable pieces for that page.
- * note: when adding fold out flaps to individual pages it is better to do this step before binding the whole book.*
- Once all the pages are assembled then bind the book. Use a binding machine and comb if available or use a 3 hole punch and add to a 3 ring binder.
